GENERAL COMMENTS & NOTES

The Items considered 'Short-Term' improvements are those that are manageable by DPW and/or Parks staff. The tasks are not large enough or specialized enough to require a formal competitive bidding process.

The items are ranked *High/Critical, High, Medium, or Low priority*.

The highest priority improvements are related to safety and/or ADA accessibility. *High/Critical* tasks pose a potential threat to health and/or safety, and are viewed as a potential liability for the City. *High* tasks are clear violations to regulations, like ADA and Consumer Product Safety. *Medium* and *Lower* priorities are associated more with aesthetics, non-safety/ADA infrastructure, enhanced recreation and site amenities.

Some of the short term improvements may be completed by skilled volunteers if the current DPW work load does not permit timely response. These items are designated with a [*V].

High/Critical priority tasks should be completed ASAP; High priority tasks to be completed within 2021/2022; Medium and Low priority tasks can be scheduled from 2022 - 2024.

Park staff should be organized into crews (A, B, C, n...) and assigned a set number of parks within a manageable geographic area within the City. Having a known crew in charge of specific parks will allow for better assessment of workmanship and overall accountability. It will hopefully grow personal responsibility and allow the staff to make more meaningful connections with local park users. The crews will also have a better pulse on current and changing needs within parks and any needed short-term improvements moving forward.

Park Standards (High): All parks should should have the following basic standards: Park signage (entrance, directional, safety, rules); Excluding the open spaces, assure adequate restroom facilities (indoor, vault, or portable based on the park); electric service and internet access. Installation of cameras linked to the Scranton Police Station and Parks and Recreation should be standard practice at park facilities.

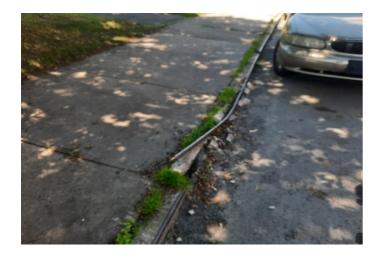
