The director will create opportunities for dialogue, information sharing, partnership, civic leadership building, and action between City government and Scranton residents.

- Oversee Recreation Manager and manage recreation budget.
- Lead project implementation from beginning to end.
- Organize regular resident outreach events.
- Manage city volunteer corps program.
- Coordinate with the Office of Community Development on neighborhood and parks projects.
- Attend Neighborhood Association and other Community Meetings.
- Build relationships with existing community leaders and identify new leaders
- Create reports to brief the Mayor and other City Departments.

REQUIRED TRAINING, EXPERIENCE, KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

Self-starter motivation with strong organizational and time management skills. Ability to accurately deal with difficult situations and to work in a team environment. Excellent communication skills (written and oral). Proficient computer skills in Word, Excel, PowerPoint.

Education equivalent to the completion of the twelfth (12th) school grade. College experience is a plus, but not mandatory, some recreational experience is desired.
