HOW TO PREPARE RECYCLING FOR THE CURB:

- Rinse out any food or liquid residue from containers before placing them in the bin.
- Cardboard must be free of contaminants such as grease or non-recyclable packing material.
- Cardboard should be broken down and combined before placing it in the bin or stacking it on the curb.
- Make sure to set your bins out no more than 24 hours before and prior to 6 AM the day of pick up.

Fall leaf pick up coincides with mixed collection starting the last week of October.

The Department of Public Works is not responsible for broken or damaged bins.
