WHAT BELONGS IN YOUR RECYCLING BINS:

RED BINS:

- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Unwanted Mail
- All types of writing paper
- Corrugated Cardboard
- Paperboard
- Cereal and Tissue Boxes

BLUE BINS:

- Plastic Bottles and Containers
 - Glass Bottles and Containers
 - Aluminum, Steel, and Tin Bottles and Containers
- HOW TO PREPARE RECYCLING FOR THE CURB**
- Rinse out any food or liquid residue from containers before placing them in the bin
 - Cardboard must be free of contaminants such as grease or non-recyclable packing material
 - Cardboard should be broken down and neatly combined before placing it in the bin or stacking it on the curb
 - Make sure to set your bins out no more than 24 hours before and prior to 6 AM the day of pick up

Unsure if an item is recyclable?

When in doubt, find out or throw it out!
